USER MANUAL - REHABILITATION SUPPORTS

Ladies and Gentlemen

Thank you for purchasing our product, we value the trust you have placed in us. We have made every effort to ensure that our equipment meets your expectations, we hope that it will be a product that will significantly facilitate your movement at home as well as during everyday walks. Before use, please read this user manual, it is absolutely necessary to follow the safety regulations. Please keep this manual, which is also a warranty card.

Product purpose:

A rehabilitation support is an auxiliary and rehabilitation device designed for disabled people with a musculoskeletal disorder, with problems with verticalization or having problems with maintaining balance while walking. It is also used to maintain balance while learning to walk after an illness



Contraindications to verticalization, injuries and dysfunctions of the upper limbs that prevent leaning on a support, impaired motor coordination, labyrinth problems, spinal instability.

Maximum patient weight to ensure safe use of the support -136kg(model: AR-032 -110kg) Maximum permissible load of shopping containers (basket, bag)-5kg



Notes and warnings:

To avoid accidents, please:

- 1. Check if all frame elements (7) are straight, not broken, damaged (e.g. during transport)
- 2. Check whether both handles/pull handles of the support (1) are set at the same height.
- 3. Check whether the handles/grips (1) of the support are tightly "tightened", screwed, preventing them from being removed
- 4. Check if the stand has all four wheels (5) and (8) AR-020 2 wheels.
- 5. Check if the wheels are securely fastened (5) and (8)
- 6. Checking whether all the elements of the support frame are firmly connected to each other (7)
- 7. Check if the support is fully extended
- 8. Do not use the support in places where it may be slippery, e.g. spilled liquid, ice.
- 9. The support should not be treated as a wheelchair applies to model AR-022



To avoid injuries:

- 1. The stand must be fully unfolded (when properly unfolded, it must look exactly as in the picture)
- 2. It is necessary to check the stability of the support each time before use.
- 3. The handles (pull handles) (1) must be set at the same height
- 4. Only use the stand on a flat, solid surface. Do not use on stairs!
- 5. Use extreme caution on wet, slippery surfaces.
- 6. When moving around, pay special attention to lying rugs, pieces of clothing, toys, etc., as well as lying animals, uneven, cracked surfaces, uneven
- 7. The support must always be held with both hands! Hands firmly gripping the handles (1), possibility of quickly pulling the brake handles (2). (does not apply to AR-020,
- 8. The stand must not be exposed to long-term extreme weather conditions (e.g. very heavy frost or direct strong sunlight)
- 9. Do not overload the support, do not exceed the maximum load allowed by the manufacturer.
- 10. The maximum permissible load of the basket/bag (3) must not be exceeded
- 11. Consult your physician before use.

12. Model AR-022 - NEVER STAND ON THE FOOTREST. DO NOT TRANSPORT THE PATIENT AS IN A WHEELCHAIR. RISK OF ACCIDENT!

The stand should be cleaned regularly using only water and mild detergents. The stand should be wiped/dried with a soft cloth. Do not use abrasive agents! Brake cables, components (wheels, handles) are consumables and must be replaced with new ones if excessive wear is detected. The above-mentioned components are not covered by the warranty. Any play in screw connections and brake adjustments are the responsibility of the user and do not constitute

Maintenance schedule:

Every weekCheck the brake for failure, check all wheels for loose bolts, nuts and axles

PeriodicallyCheck the brackets for wear, check that the frame bolts are tight, check that the front and rear axle bolts are tight, check the "fatigue" of the

Troubleshooting:

If you have any problems, please review this section. If this does not help, please contact your point of sale or service. Repairing the stand yourself is PROHIBITED!!! This can cause an accident.

I. The stand is not stable.

- a. Are both support handles (1) at the same height? If not, adjust them correctly.
- b. Are the clamps/screws (6) securely tightened/tightened? If not, tighten/tighten them.
- c. Is the kickstand fully extended? If not, extend it and check its stability.
- d. Are all the wheels (5) and (8) tightened securely? If not, tighten them securely.
- e. Are all the parts of the support frame (7) securely connected? If not, contact your point of sale. DO NOT USE THE SUPPORT!!!

Incidents:

Preparation for use

- 1. Remove the support from the cardboard or foil packaging.
- 2. First of all, check the technical condition of the support in accordance with point Notes and warnings.
- 3. Insert the handles and push handles (1) into the holes in the frame (7). See the drawing above.
- 4. Clamp/screw the handles and push handles (1) to the frame (7) in such a way that they cannot be removed.
- 5. Adjust the height of the support and push handles (1) to the user's height. To do this, unscrew/remove the clamp (AR-005), screw (AR-006, AR-020, AR-021, AR-022), latch (AR-007, AR-032) (6) located in the frame (7). Set the required height by sliding or sliding them together. Reinsert the screw/ latch into the existing hole in the frame, tighten/tighten. Repeat the operation for both support handles. The pushing handles (1) must be at the
- 6. After unfolding, it is absolutely necessary to check the correct operation of the brakes (does not apply to AR-020, AR-021). Place your hands on the handles (1), pull the brake handles up with your fingers (2) and then check whether the clamps block the wheels with the brakes (5). Additionally, after the test, push the brake handles (2) with your fingers as far down as possible until the latch "clicks". The brake should be in the parking position and then check by gently pushing the walker forward whether the wheels are blocked.
- 7. Install the basket, tray (AR-005, AR-022), bag (AR-007, AR-032) (3). See the drawing above.

Alternatively, please consult your doctor, physical therapist or point of sale for precise instructions on appropriate use.

End of Use:

- 1. Fold the stand by sliding the front wheels and rear wheels/legs towards each other (AR-005, AR-006, AR-020, AR-021, AR-022).
- 2. In the AR-006, AR-020, AR-021, AR-022, AR-032 model, the folding handle is located under the seat. Fold the support (AR-007) by sliding the right and left wheels towards each other by pulling the handle in the seat.

Cleaning and storage:

- 1. Place the support in a place where it will not be exposed to mechanical damage.
- 2. In case of dirt, refer to the "Maintenance Method" section of this manual.
